Theology and Practice of Spiritual Care

【Re: *Pastoral Ministry (牧會學), in Canadian Chinese Churches*】

I. Course Description:

The purpose of this course is to examine church ceremonies and to challenge students in applying their understanding of the theology to local church ministry practice.

Chinese churches in North America are bi-cultural. Local church pastors must be sensitive to the language and the background of the congregation when performing church ceremonies.

Therefore, the biblical and cultural methodologies for ministering to the North American Chinese churches will be examined and discussed.

II. Course Expectations and Objectives:

- a. To examine and to evaluate the theological, biblical and cultural principles behind each of these ceremonies, such as: baptism, communion, anointing for healing, baby dedication, funeral service, wedding service, installation service, and ordination service. The role as a chairperson in the Chinese Elder Broad, the role as a peacemaker-pastor in Chinese churches, the role in the testimonies against the powers of darkness/demonic spirits, the role as a discipleship trainer, the role of an every-Sunday-preacher and the role as a pastoral counselor will be also examined.
- b. To rehearse some of the above ceremonies.
- c. To learn to apply each of the ceremonies in a local church setting, as it may differ depending upon church size and congregation.
- d. To discuss real life pastoral ministry issues, provided by the students.
